Obituary

Bobbie Eugene North, age 68, of Porter departed this life on Monday, July 28, 2008 at his residence in Porter. Bobbie was born on April 14, 1940 in Duke, Oklahoma to Eugene W. and AmaDean (Alexander) North. He graduated from Central View High School and then attended a community college in Clarendon, Texas. He enlisted in the United States Army on June 11, 1963 and was honorably discharged on June 3, 1965. In August 1985, Bobbie and Mary "Chris" Sell were united in marriage in Gore, Oklahoma.
