Bobby Tom (Catfish) Bryant, age 81, resident of Coweta, Oklahoma went to be with his Lord and Savior on Wednesday, December 29, 2021 at the Coweta Manor Nursing Home in Coweta, Oklahoma. Bob was born on August 24, 1940 in Albion, Oklahoma to Joseph and Ada Geraldine (Bowles) Bryant. He attended Talihina High School and graduated in 1959. He married the love of his life, Ann Leslie Pickard, on November 2nd, 1963 and they were married 55 years until her passing in 2019. Bob also attended Spartan School of Aeronautics where he graduated in 1963. He retired in 2002 after 33 years as an Avionics Maintenance Supervisor for American Airlines. Bob was instrumental in helping establish Green Country Soccer which included the Coweta and Broken Arrow Soccer Clubs. He served as Youth Commissioner for the Oklahoma Soccer Association from 1976-1978. He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and coach who was known for his humor, proud of his Choctaw heritage and a man of faith.
