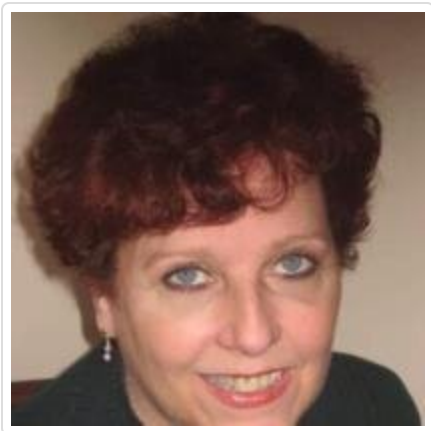




Dana Gail Patten
