Obituary

Darold Leon Wasson, age 77, of Sevierville, Tennessee (formerly of Coweta, Oklahoma) departed this life on Thursday, April 1, 2010 in Sevierville, Tennessee. He was born on January 20, 1933 in Coweta, Oklahoma to William Dailey and Cora (Meadows) Wasson. Darold was a loving husband, father, brother, and grandfather to his family. He graduated with Technical degree from Oklahoma State University School of Lithographing. Darold and Dainese Oler were united in marriage on October 2, 1953 in Coweta, Oklahoma. He was a member of Richardson Cove Baptist Church in Sevierville, Tennessee and a former member of the First Baptist Church in Coweta, Oklahoma. Darold was a lifetime member of Coweta chapter of Future Farmers of America. His hobbies included gardening, spending time with his grandchildren, raising and training German Shepherds, beekeeping, raising and working with livestock, traveling, hunting and fishing. He entered as a Private and was promoted to Corporal and honorably discharged as Sergeant with letters of commendation from his commanding officer. Darold will be dearly missed by his family and friends.
