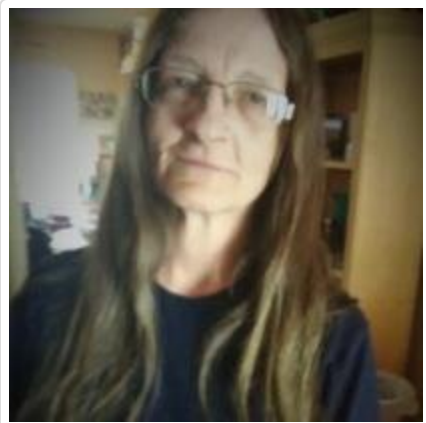




Eve Marie Rogers
