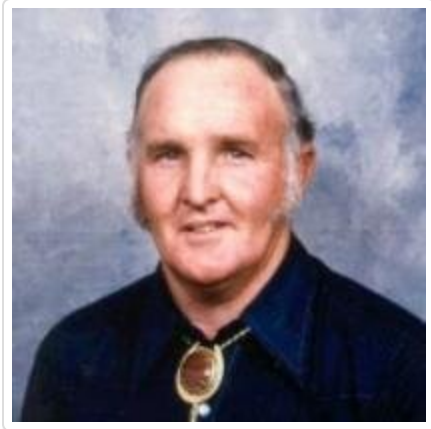




Horace Johnson

Obituary
