She stood up for what she knew was right, and may not agree with everybody, but she was not disagreeable. She loved Saturday Night Live, and actresses Jennifer Anniston and Jenny McCarthy, and scary movies as well as Will Ferrell comedies. She loved nature, her favorite flowers being calla lilies

and sunflowers. She liked to garden vegetables and fruits and take care of her pets. Jerilyn always had horses, dogs, and pet pigs.
