Kenneth Oscar Hughes, age 85, lifelong Coweta resident went to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday morning, December 4, 2020 at his home in Coweta, Oklahoma surrounded by his daughters. Kenneth was born on December 26, 1934 in Coweta, Oklahoma and was the son of Oscar Curtis and Ruth Mae (Bryan) Hughes.

Kenneth attended Liberty School and Coweta Public Schools where he was a 1952 graduate of Coweta High School. After graduating, he attended Bacone College for two years and played football and boxed. Kenneth was a proud veteran of the United States Army, serving in the Korean War era and was an Army Intelligence Officer. He entered the Army on October 22, 1954 and was honorably discharged on October 2, 1957. Kenneth married the love of his life, Wanda Ellen Burrows on September 26, 1958 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was a mail carrier for the United States Postal Service for over 35 years until he retired on April 12, 1991. Kenneth was a faithful member of the First Christian Church in Coweta where he was a song leader for many years. He enjoyed sports, fishing, golfing, coaching, singing, and working on the farm with his dad and brothers. His love for God was evident in how he loved and cared for his family and those around him. Because of God's love in his life, he will live on in the hearts of those that knew and loved him.
