He always wanted to have a job and was an exceptional employee, earning the coveted "Employee of the Year" for Tulsa, OK. During his career that spanned over two decades, he worked at Bill's Grocery in Broken Arrow, Oral Roberts University and Wal-Mart. Larry was active in the People's First of Oklahoma, where he served as Sergeant-at-Arms. One of his other dreams was to have his own house. For several years, he lived in an apartment in Broken Arrow. After a difficult surgery four years ago, Larry was no longer able to work or walk, and moved in with his sister angel, Cleta Myrick of Chouteau. Larry is survived by five sisters: Cleta Myrick of Chouteau, Sharon Richard and husband Norman of Towanda, KS, Glinna Fleming and husband Tom of Locust Grove, Brenda Simmons and husband Tim of Tulsa and Marilyn Harmon and husband Steve of Blackwell. Larry also has several nieces and nephews and great-nieces and nephews that meant the world to him. He was

preceded in death by his parents Paul and Jean Walker; his brother Bobby Walker; and three infant siblings.
