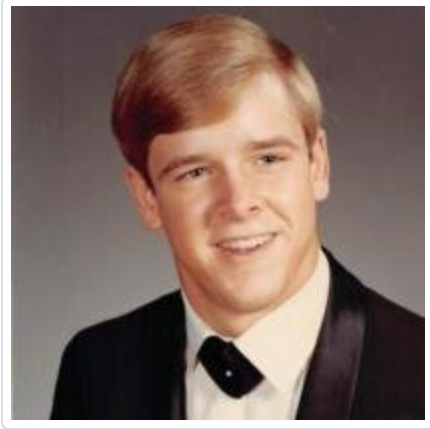




Larry Gene Venable
