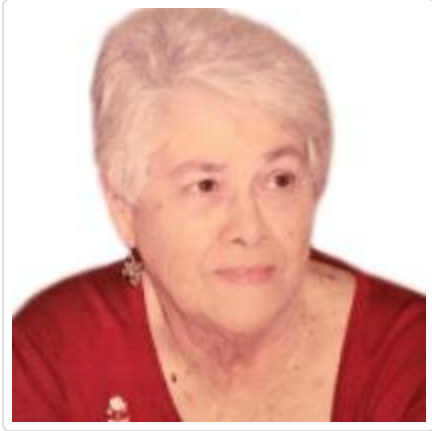




Louetta Smith
