### Obituary

July 29, 2011 Paul Cecil Baker was born September 12, 1926 in Wagoner County, three miles east of Broken Arrow, OK to Irvin and Ruth Baker. He departed at his home in Chelsea, OK with family at his side to be with the Lord early Monday morning, October 12, 2009. Paul was a World War II veteran serving in the Army of the United States Air Force, 13th Air Service Group, where he was awarded the WWII Victory Medal and the Army of Occupation Medal.
