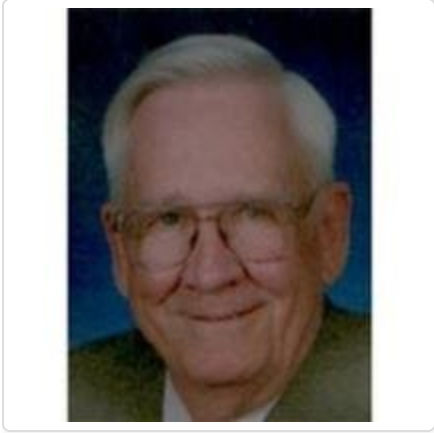




William Clifton Ada
